AUTOMATED SOLID WASTE COLLECTION COLLECTED WEEKLY (SEE SCHEDULE)

GUIDELINES:

- Trash carts must be curbside by 7am collection day & removed by 7am the day after.
- **All trash** must be bagged & placed in the provided City of Maumelle trash cart.
- Cart must be 3 feet from fence, mailbox, recycle bin, yard waste bags, and any other obstructions. If residence has more than one trash cart, place them 3ft apart as well.
- Place cart at curb **with handle facing away from street.**
- Do not place cart directly under overhead objects.
- Building materials, construction debris, auto parts, wet paint, medical waste, used oils, and tires cannot be placed in carts.
- Overfilled carts will not be collected.
- Additional carts are available at \$5.00/month for 2nd cart & \$3.50/month for each cart beyond the first two.
- Please see **Special Collection** section for quantities falling outside these guidelines.

YARD WASTE

COLLECTED WEEKLY (SEE SCHEDULE)

GUIDELINES:

- Must be at curb by 7am on collection day.
- Leaves, grass clippings, pine needles, small shrubs & small twigs must be bagged.
- Bags must not exceed 35lbs.
- Tree limbs must not exceed 5 feet long & 3 inches in diameter.
- Place limbs parallel to the curb.
- Limbs must be tied & bundled with twine or other compostable material.
- One person should be able to handle each bundle.
- Please see the **Special Collection** and the **Transfer Station** section for details & fees.

**DO NOT PLACE YARD WASTE IN TRASH CARTS.
WE DO NOT PICK UP CONTRACTOR WASTE.**

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

All special pick-ups require payment before collection. Special collection refers to the removal of large bulky items that will not fit in the trash cart.

Fee Schedule:

- \$30.00 minimum for 3 cubic yards or less
- Additional cubic yards \$10.00 each

ANNUAL SPRING & FALL CLEAN UP

Bulk waste clean ups are scheduled city wide during April and October every year. Zone schedules for the clean up are listed below. Please have all items curbside by 7am on collection day.

- items **NOT** accepted: tires, electronic waste, household waste (trash), yard waste, appliances containing freon, construction waste, wet paint, fencing or decking, contractors waste (**no exceptions**).

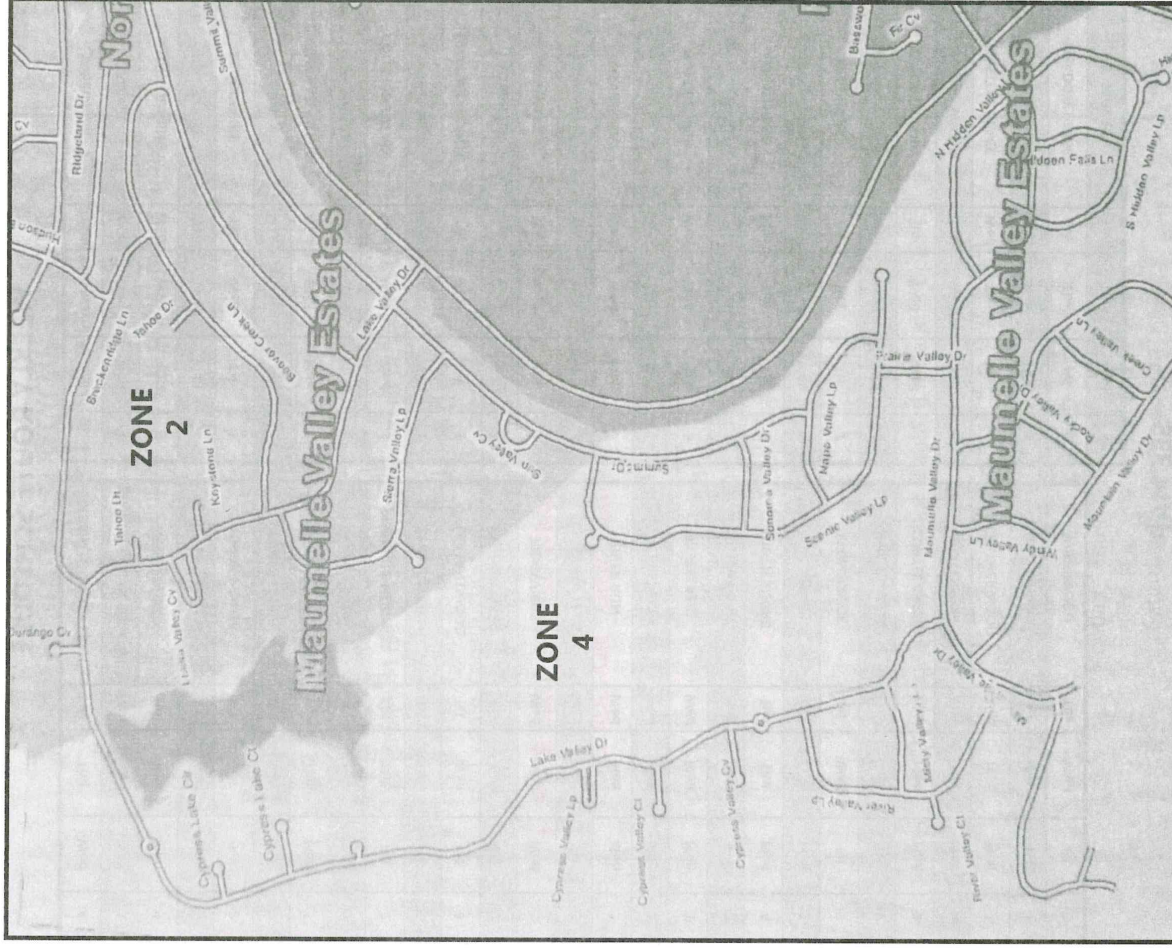

TRANSFER STATION & RECYCLING CENTER

#423 COGDELL DRIVE

- Only Maumelle residents that have their curbside solid waste/yard waste collection picked up by the City of Maumelle Public Works Department/Sanitation Services may dispose of waste at the transfer station.
- PROOF OF MAUMELLE RESIDENCY MUST BE SHOWN IN ORDER TO DISPOSE OF SOLID OR YARD WASTE.**
- The scheduled fee is dependent upon the size of the load. The MINIMUM fee is \$10.00. All fees must be paid at the gate before entry to dump.
- Acceptable waste includes but not limited to: large bulky items, yard waste, construction waste generated by the resident, & everyday solid waste.
- NOTE: HIRED HELP (CONTRACTORS) PAID BY RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DISPOSAL OF DEBRIS – YARD OR CONSTRUCTION – GENERATED BY THEIR WORK.**

Maumelle City Code

Sec. 62-33. – Solid waste collection fee. (a) Each residential unit shall pay to the city a monthly fee of **\$23.13** for once a week service of collecting residential solid waste, refuse (including yard waste) and recyclables. This fee includes the issuance of one city solid waste container and one recycling container. Residents may rent additional solid waste containers from the city at an additional cost of \$3.50 per month for the first additional cart and \$5.00 per month for any subsequent additional cart. All residents in multifamily attached housing areas using city services for solid waste collection purposes shall have a residential cart issued by the city which is marked so as to identify the household to which they are rented

Please be aware of this change from \$15.50 to \$23.13.
